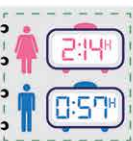

Environment and Health

Wastewater Disposal (2016):



48% of schools dispose of wastewater through a **sewage network**.



54% of Palestinian families dispose of their wastewater through a **sewage network**.



39% dispose of their wastewater in **cesspits**.



32% dispose of their wastewater in **cesspits**.



Solid Waste Management (2016):

8% of higher education institutions
5% of schools
5% of kindergartens
get rid of their solid waste in a random manner.
