

Selected Statistics on Children and Education¹



50,000 students experience difficulties in accessing education due to the lack of schools, exposure to danger and the risk of demolishing schools.



10,000 Palestinian children learn in tents and classrooms made of tin.



More than **700** children cross 3-8 kilos to reach their schools.



2,500 children are daily have to pass through checkpoints in order to reach school.

77 health facilities were completely or partly demolished.




54,000 children are homeless.
